LOCATION: Kilkenny is located in southeastern Ireland. The town is the county seat of the county of the same name. The town is situated on the banks of the River Nore, at an elevations of some 210 feet above sea level. Kilkenny is best known as the site of Kilkenny Castle, and St. Canice's Cathedral.

COMMENTS: Bright sunshine is likely on 29% of the daylight hours of the year. This might range from a low of 20% in December, to a "high" of 35% in April and May. The lowest temperature of the year should be close to 17 on some calm and clear winter sunrise, and the highest should be near 78 on some sunny and windless summer afternoon. Sensible temperatures (the ones you actually feel) will be two to three degrees cooler than actual ones during warmer weather. The area has a four-season year, with short mild to cool summers and long cool to cold winters. Snowfall is extremely variable from year to year and from place to place. Since rain is far more common than snow, the latter rarely remains on the ground for long. The best weather comes from April through September, with the earlier months being sunnier, and the later ones a touch warmer.
