SUNSHINE GUIDE TO THE SALVADOR DE BAHIA AREA, BRAZIL

LOCATION: The city of Salvador de Bahia is usually called simply "Bahia". It is located in the periodically drought-stricken Northeast of Brazil. Bahia is situated on a peninsula separating the sheltered waters of the Bahia de Todos Santos (All-Saints Bay) from the rougher waters of the South Atlantic Ocean. The city is centered on the bay side, and faces west. Elevations are within a few hundred feet of sea level.

COMMENTS: Bahia has a rainy tropical climate. The length of the daylight period does not vary much from one month to another, nor do temperatures. Rainfall is abundant (sometimes more than abundant) in all months, although January tends to be a touch on the dry side. Rainfall peaks in April and May, when three out of four days get substantial rain. Afternoon humidities are high throughout the year, making sensible temperatures (the ones you actually feel) anywhere from 1° to 5° hotter than those shown on the table above or on thermometers. In this region, an air-conditioned room is more of a necessity than a luxury for most people's comfort. Below-freezing temperatures are unknown, and the lowest temperature of the year will be only in the middle 60's. It is most likely to occur just about sunrise following some clear night in August.
