SUNSHINE GUIDE TO THE CONECUH FOREST RECREATION AREA, ALABAMA

LOCATION: The Conecuh Forest Recreation Area is located on more than 130 square miles of mixed upland forest and swamp in south-central Alabama, up against the Florida border. Most of the area is under the administration of the Conecuh National Forest. The Forest HQ is in Andalusia. The area continues on the other side of the border as Blackwater State Forest. Elevations average around two to three-hundred feet above sea level. Activities include hunting, fishing, boating (Blue Lake, Brook Hines Lake, and Open Pond), hiking along the Conecuh Trail, camping, and picnicking. Swimming is allowed at Blue Lake, but is unsafe at other areas due to the presence of alligators.

COMMENTS: Bright sunshine is likely on 64% of the year's daylight hours. This might range from a low of 51% in December, to a high of 72% in October. The year's lowest temperature should be close to 19° on some clear winter's sunrise, and the highest should be near 101° on some windless summer afternoon. Sensible afternoon temperatures (the ones you feel) will be up to 3° cooler than actual ones during the winter months, and up to 7° hotter than actual ones during the summer months. The area gets a standard four-season year, with long very hot summers and short mild winters. Humidities are high throughout the year. Snow flurries are not unknown during the winter months, but will not occur every year. Snow on the ground is extremely rare. Early spring (frontal storms) and mid-summer (thunderstorms) are the wettest season, with autumn the driest. October gets the best all-around weather of the year, although many residents prefer the blossoming season of April. At all times of the year, protection against biting insects is a must.
