SUNSHINE GUIDE TO THE MIDWAY ISLANDS, HAWAII

LOCATION: The Midway Islands are located in the North Pacific Ocean a bit over a thousand miles northwest of the Hawaiian Islands, of which they are an administrative part. The islands were under the control of the U. S. Navy until 1996, and have no indigenous population. There are two atolls, Sand Atoll and Eastern Atoll, totaling some four square miles of land area. Elevations are everywhere close to sea level. The islands are now a popular eco-tourism destination, and are run by the Midway Phoenix Corporation in conjunction with the U. S. Fish and Wildlife Service. Visitors are accommodated in refurbished military installations. Activities include snorkeling, fishing, and birding.

COMMENTS: Bright sunshine is likely on 67% of the daylight hours of the year. This might range from a low of 50% in January, to a high of 86% in July. The lowest temperature of the year should be close to 54° on some calm and clear January sunrise, and the highest should be near 88° on some sunny and windless September afternoon. Sensible temperatures (the ones you actually feel) will be up to 4° warmer than actual ones from May through November, due to the high humidity. The best weather comes from April through July.
