SUNSHINE GUIDE TO JOHNSTON ATOLL, NORTH PACIFIC OCEAN

LOCATION: Johnston Atoll is located in the northern Pacific Ocean some 717 miles southwest of the Hawaiian Islands. The group consists of Johnston Island and three smaller islets, the total land mass being about one square mile. Most of this is dredge spoils, as the island areas were increased to allow construction of an airfield and subsidiary structures. Elevations are less than 25 feet above sea level, and there is almost no native vegetation. The atoll is administered jointly by the Defense Nuclear Agency and the U. S. Fish and Wildlife Service. Access is limited.

COMMENTS: Bright sunshine is likely on 71% of the daylight hours of the year. This might range from a low of 59% in November, to a high of 78% in July. The lowest temperature of the year should be close to 65 on some calm and clear January sunrise, and the highest should be near 89 on some sunny and windless September afternoon. Sensible temperatures (the ones you actually feel) will be up to 6° hotter than actual ones, due to the combination of temperature and humidity. The atoll lies within the belt of the Northeast Trade Winds, and these winds predominate most of the year. There is very little difference in the weather from one month to the next. The weather on any given day could (and probably will) occur in any month of the year. That being said, the best weather occurs in January and February.
