COMMENTS: The area has a tropical wet-and-dry season. Below-freezing temperatures occur perhaps once a century. In most years, the high 40's is as cold as it will get. Temperatures of that sort can be expected some January sunrise following a clear, still night. The rainy season corresponds to the Southwest Monsoon, and will run from May through September in most years. The dry season takes up the rest of the year, and corresponds mostly with the Northeast Monsoon. The hottest time of year usually comes in March and April, just before the onset of the rainy monsoon. At the beginning of the rainy season, rains are more common in the afternoon and early evening. As the rains progress, they occur at any time of the day or night. Since it does lie within the tropics, the area does experience the sun directly overhead at local noon. This occurs twice. The first time will be during the second week in May, the second during the first week in August. The area gets about 45 minutes per day of twilight, half at dawn and half at dusk.
