SUNSHINE GUIDE TO THE KARACHI AREA, PAKISTAN

LOCATION: Karachi, Pakistan's largest city and major port, is located on the shores of the Arabian Sea in southeastern Pakistan. The city is situated on a natural harbor just to the west of the current delta of the Indus River. Elevations in this sprawling city are everywhere close to sea level.

COMMENTS: The area has a desert version of the four-season monsoon year. These are not the same four seasons familiar to dwellers in the mid-latitudes. The pre-monsoon hot season starts in April and continues until the "burst" of the rainy southwest monsoon in July. It is the hottest time of year, with increasing afternoon humidities as it progresses. Sensible temperatures (the ones you actually feel) are up to 15°F hotter than actual ones, due to the combination of temperature, humidity, and intense sunshine. The succeeding rainy monsoon season is brief, and usually comes to an end in early August. Nevertheless, it brings the bulk of the year's rain and oppressive humidities. The third season is the post-monsoon hot season from late August through early November. It is both less hot and less humid than the pre-monsoon hot season. This is followed by the "cool" season of December through March, which is quite pleasant, and by far the best weather of the year. The length of these various seasons, when they start and when they finish varies considerably from one year to another.
