## SUNSHINE GUIDE TO THE ST. PETERSBURG AREA, RUSSIA

LOCATION: St. Petersburg (known as Leningrad, for a time) is located in northwestern Russia. The city is situated on the banks of the Neva River, at the head of the Gulf of Finland (an arm of the Baltic Sea). Elevations are everywhere close to sea level.

COMMENTS: At almost 60° north of the Equator, St. Petersburg has a mid-latitude, four-season, short-summer, humid-continental climate. Precipitation is light but adequate in all months, with a summer maximum. Summers are short and mild, winters are long and very cold. Spring and autumn are seasons of transition. Clear days are rare, and most common in spring and early summer. Over the course of the year, you can expect about one day in ten will be essentially clear. June leads all months with 20% such clear days. November is likely to have only a single clear day--not even that in some years. The December sun only gets about 8° above the horizon at its highest point of the day. The river is frozen solid enough to support pedestrian traffic from November through early April. The calendar dominates the weather in this part of the world.
