

SUNSHINE GUIDE TO THE REGINA AREA, SASKATCHEWAN, CANADA

LOCATION: Regina is Saskatchewan's capital and largest city. It is situated in the vast levelness of the northern Great Plains. Elevations everywhere are within a few hundred feet of 1,900 feet above sea level.

COMMENTS: The area has a four-season year with short warm (occasionally hot) summers, and long very cold winters. Bright sunshine occurs on 52% of the year's daylight hours, ranging from a low of 34% in December to a high of 68% in July. The low temperature for the year will be near -41° some windless winter sunrise, while the high will be around 97° some sunny summer afternoon. The weather is given to extremes. Temperatures over 100°F have occurred in every month from May through September. And, below-freezing temperatures have occurred in every month, although July is usually frost-free. From December through February, half the nights regularly drop below zero. A hardy land with a hardy people.
