

SUNSHINE GUIDE TO THE LUXEMBOURG CITY AREA, LUXEMBOURG

LOCATION: The Grand Duchy of Luxembourg is located in the uplands between the Ardennes region of Belgium, the Rhineland of Germany, and the Lorraine region of France. The capital and primate city (also Luxembourg) is situated on the Alzette River in the fertile Gutland plateau area in the south-central part of the country. Elevations within the city are over a thousand feet above sea level.

COMMENTS: Bright sunshine is likely on 36% of the year's daylight hours. This might range from a low of 15% in December (more than half of December days get no sunshine at all), to a high of 47% in July and August. The year's lowest temperature should be close to 9°, and the highest should be near 87°. Sensible afternoon temperatures (the ones you feel) will be pretty much the same as actual ones during the cooler months, but up to 3° cooler than actual ones during the warmer months. Humidities are always high, and morning humidities will be at or near saturation most of the time. Warm weather dews and cold-weather frosts are common, as are light early morning mists. Snowfalls tend to be light to moderate, and to vary considerably from one year to the next. Even in the winter, rain is more common than snow. When snow does fall, it does not remain on the ground for long.
