## SUNSHINE GUIDE TO INVERNESS AND LOCH NESS, SCOTLAND

LOCATION: Inverness, the capital of the Northern Highlands, is located in northeastern Scotland. The town is situated on the River Ness between Loch Ness (and its monster) and the Moray Firth, an arm of the north sea. Elevations in town are all within a few hundred feet of sea level. However, the mountainous highlands rise several thousand feet higher on either side of the narrow lake.

COMMENTS: Bright sunshine is likely on only 28% of the year's daylight hours. This might range from a low of 16% in December, to a high of 33% in May. The year's lowest temperature should be close to 17°, and the highest should be near 77°. Sensible afternoon temperatures (the ones you feel) will be a few degrees cooler than actual ones during the already cool to mild summer afternoons, due to the high humidities. Winter months are quite stormy, with gale force winds on about a quarter of the days. These same winds, coming off of relatively warm seas, keep the winter temperatures from getting anywhere near as cold as these same latitudes farther from the sea. May through September brings the best weather for a visit.
