SUNSHINE GUIDE TO TURBO AND THE GOLFO DE URABA, COLOMBIA

LOCATION: The banana port of Turbo is located at the western end of Colombia's Caribbean Coast, not too far from the Panamanian border. The town sits on the eastern side of the Golfo de Uraba, in a marshy area cut by canals and minor waterways. Elevations are everywhere close to sea level. Turbo is a "jumping-off" point for visits to nearby national parks and for the overland trip to the Darien region of Panama.

COMMENTS: Turbo has a rainy tropical climate. There is no real dry season, although in most years the period from January through early April is somewhat less wet. There is little change in the length of the daylight period from one season to another, and even less change in temperatures. Humidities will be close to or at saturation at night, and quite high during the day. This makes the sensible temperatures (the ones you actually feel) some six degrees higher than those shown in the table or on thermometers. The weather on any given day could just as easily occur on any day of the year. In short, no matter when you come, you will find it cloudy, hot, humid, and wet. It's a great climate for bananas, but travelers might not enjoy it as much.
