## SUNSHINE GUIDE TO FORT MATANZAS NATIONAL MONUMENT, FLORIDA

LOCATION: Fort Matanzas National Monument is located on the Atlantic coast of northeastern Florida. The Monument is situated on barrier islands at the mouth of the Matanzas River, some fifteen miles south of St. Augustine. The Monument consists of some 300 acres, only part of which is open to the public. Much of the lower end of Anastasia Island is set aside as the Least Tern nesting area and wildlife preserve. The Visitor Center is located off FL-A1A on Anastasia Island. A short ferry ride leads to Fort Matanzas on Rattlesnake Island. There are nature trails, boardwalks, and car access to a portion of the beach on Anastasia Island. Elevations are everywhere close to sea level.

COMMENTS: Bright sunshine is likely on 63% of the daylight hours of the year. This might range from a low of 54% in December, to a high of 72% in April. The lowest temperature of the year should be close to 27, and the highest should be near 98. Sensible afternoon temperatures (the ones you feel) will be substantially higher than actual ones from June through September. Humidities are high throughout the year. Winter (December through February) has mild to warm days (sometimes quite cool) and chilly to cold nights. Temperatures will drop below freezing on three or four occasions during the winter nights. Summer (June through September) features hot to very hot days and warm and sultry nights. Afternoon and evening thundershowers are characteristic of this season. Spring and autumn are seasons of transition, but bring the Monument some of its best weather of the year. The official hurricane season runs from June through November. Fort Matanzas has one chance in fifty of having a hurricane pass over in any given year.
