SUNSHINE GUIDE TO THE WACONDA LAKE RECREATION AREA, KANSAS

LOCATION: Waconda Lake is located in Mitchell County in north-central Kansas. It is situated on the Solomon River, some sixty miles northwest of Salina. The lake was created in 1968 by the construction of Glen Elder Dam. The lake covers some twenty square miles, with roughly a hundred miles of shoreline. Crest elevation is 1,500 feet above sea level. Glen Elder State Park is located near the dam, just outside the community of Glen Elder. The lake is a popular fishing and summer recreation site. The surrounding countryside is flat to gently rolling.

COMMENTS: Bright sunshine is likely on 68% of the daylight hours of the year. This might range from a low of 58% in December, to a high of 80% in July. The lowest temperature of the year should be close to -13 on some calm and clear winter sunrise, and the highest should be near 108 on some sunny and windless summer afternoon. Sensible temperatures (the ones you actually feel) will be very close to actual ones. The area has a four-season, mid-latitude, continental climate. Its distance from any ocean leads to a lack of marine moderation, and both temperatures and precipitation vary widely from season to season and from year to year. The 121° annual temperature fluctuation is an example. In addition, both drought and floods are factors to be reckoned with. The best weather comes from the middle of May through late September.
