SUNSHINE GUIDE TO PETOSKEY AND LITTLE TRAVERSE BAY, MICHIGAN

LOCATION: Little Traverse Bay is located on the northwestern Lake Michigan shoreline of Michigan's lower peninsula. Or, as Michigan natives would say, "At the tip of the ring finger"—referring to the "mitten" shape of that peninsula. Petoskey, a very up-scale resort community, is situated on the south shore of Little Traverse bay, near its eastern end. Elevations are around 700 feet above sea level, or a few tens of feet above lake level.

COMMENTS: Bright sunshine is likely on 49% of the daylight hours of the year. This might range from a low of 26% in December, to a high of 66% in July. The lowest temperature of the year should be close to -15 on some calm and clear winter sunrise, and the highest should be near 90 on some sunny and windless summer afternoon. Sensible temperatures (the ones you actually feel) will be up to 3° cooler than actual ones during spring and autumn, and essentially the same as actual ones the rest of the year. From December through early March, more than half of the afternoons will fail to warm to above freezing, and about a dozen mornings will start out below zero. Snowfall amounts vary widely from year to year and from place to place within the area, due to variations in topography and the lake effect. The best weather comes from late May through August.
