SUNSHINE GUIDE TO MISSOULA AND THE BITTERROOT MOUNTAINS, MONTANA

LOCATION: Missoula is located in Missoula County in the central part of Montana's far west. The town is situated on the Clark's Fork of the Missouri River at the foot of the Bitterroot Mountains. Elevations are a bit over 3,000 feet above sea level. Missoula is Montana's cultural center, and the home of the University of Montana. It is very much an outdoor-related community. I-90 connects it with Idaho and the rest of Montana.

COMMENTS: Bright sunshine is likely on 54% of the daylight hours of the year. This might range from a low of 28% in December, to a high of 80% in July. The lowest temperature of the year should be close to -17 on some calm and clear winter sunrise, and the highest should be near 99 on some sunny and windless summer afternoon. Sensible temperatures (the ones you actually feel) will be up to 4° cooler than actual ones during the summer months, and pretty much the same as actual ones during the winter months. Winters are long and cold. From November through February, about one afternoon in three will fail to warm to above freezing, and a dozen sunrises will start out below zero. July and August bring the area its best weather.
