## SUNSHINE GUIDE TO THE DELAWARE WATER GAP NRA, NEW JERSEY & PENNSYLVANIA

LOCATION: The Delaware Water Gap National Recreation Area is located on the border between northwestern New Jersey and northeastern Pennsylvania. The NRA is situated on both sides of the Delaware River as it runs through the Appalachian Mountains and finally breaks through to the middle-Atlantic coastal plain at Delaware Water Gap. The NRA stretches some 40 miles and covers roughly 105 square miles of forest, river, and rural countryside. Visitor Centers are located at Bushkill, Dingman's Falls, Kittatinny Point, and Millbrook Village. Activities include river-running, camping, hiking, fishing, swimming, picnicking, bicycling, cross-country skiing, and horseback riding.

COMMENTS: Bright sunshine is likely on 53% of the daylight hours of the year. This might range from a low of 39% in December, to a high of 63% in July. The lowest temperature of the year should be close to -10 on some calm and clear winter sunrise, and the highest should be near 100 on some sunny and windless summer afternoon. Sensible temperatures (the ones you actually feel) will be pretty much the same as actual ones. During the winter months, the river usually ices over, and nighttime temperatures will drop below zero about a half-dozen times. Snowfall figures are for the river valley. Snow will come earlier, fall heavier, and stay later in the higher elevations. Snowfalls are highly variable from year to year and place to place. Most visitors come during the summer months, and some facilities are open only then. September and October probably have the nicest weather of the year.
