COMMENTS: Bright sunshine is likely on 84% of the year's daylight hours. This might range from a low of 77% in December and January, to a high of 93% in June. The year's lowest temperature should be close to 20°, and the highest should be near 113°. Sensible afternoon temperatures (the ones you actually feel) will be from 4° to 15° cooler than actual ones. Las Vegas is a world-class destination that everyone should visit at least once in their lifetime. Gambling is the chief attraction, but there are world-famous entertainers, and free shows and displays of every kind. Then there is simple the sight of the Strip itself. Money talks in Las Vegas.
